GRANT AWARDED FOR RURAL ACCESS MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT

Tennessee Health Commissioner Dr. Ralph Alvarado recently visited the Clinic to announce a \$1.15 million grant to establish a rural access mobile health unit, expanding healthcare services to underserved areas of our region. This initiative is a collaborative effort between the Tennessee Department of Health and Mountain Hope Good Shepherd Clinic, aimed at addressing healthcare and improving access to essential services.

Dr. Alvarado emphasized the importance of reaching rural communities with quality healthcare. The grant will enable the clinic to extend its services into areas of Sevier County that face barriers such as limited transportation and medical service availability. The mobile health unit will offer primary care, behavioral healthcare, preventive screenings, vaccinations, and wellness education. This comprehensive approach aims to improve health outcomes, enhance preventive care measures, and promote overall health among uninsured residents and the local workforce.

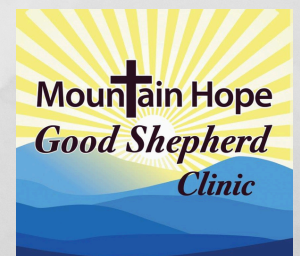
