## Dr. Dew Named Outstanding Alumnus by University of Tennessee Medical School

The University of Tennessee College of Medicine Alumni Association has named Dr. Richard Dew the Outstanding Alumnus of the University of Tennessee Medical School for 2023.

Dr. Dew has been the Medical Director of Mountain Hope Clinic in Sevierville, Tennessee for twenty years. He has also been the Chapter Leader of The Compassionate Friends organization for the last thirty years, which is an international support group for families whose children have died. He is a clinical instructor and guest lecturer for medical students at ETSU Quillen College of Medicine in Johnson City, Tennessee.

Dr. Dew is so deserving of this recognition and award. For twenty years, he has been a dedicated leader, trained numerous primary care providers, and provided compassionate quality health care to our patients.

His care of thousands of patients at Mountain Hope Good Shepherd Clinic has been an act of heartfelt giving. His commitment to addressing the health disparities for the uninsured has resulted in early diagnosis and treatment of cancer and chronic diseases.

In his book, *When Sorrow Comes*, Dr. Dew describes his service to others as a way of remembering his son and making sure his son's life could still make a difference.
